GREATER LONDON DEPUTY LIEUTENANTS' CERTIFICATES

RULES AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

Background

1. In 1984, the Lord-Lieutenant of Greater London agreed to a scheme to award Deputy Lieutenants' (DL) Certificates to outstanding cadets of the Sea Cadet Corps, Army Cadet Force and RAF Air Cadets in each borough. In 2015, the award of certificates was extended to include the Combined Cadet Force and in 2018 to include all 12 uniformed youth organisations of YOU London.

Aim

2. The aim of this award is to recognise the achievements of the best young people in each borough in each of the YOU London organisations and to create an awareness of their contribution within the community.

Award details

3. The Representative DL presents framed DL Certificates - provided by the Greater London Reserve Forces' and Cadets' Association (GL RFCA) - annually within each borough, either during a visit to a unit/group, at a joint presentation with the Mayor or at any other suitable occasion during the year.

Eligibility

4. A young person should belong to a uniformed youth group in a London borough, but special arrangements can be made for an award involving a unit/group outside the London metropolitan boundary but within the M25.

5. The question to be asked of a unit/group is **Who is the best young person you have in your unit/group and what have they achieved?**

Qualifications and standards

6. Differences between organisations make it impracticable to stipulate the qualifications required for an award, but candidates are expected to be worthy representatives of their organisation, assessed on professional performance, personal qualities, social responsibility and other achievements in fields such as education, sport and the Duke of Edinburgh's Award.

7. All candidates should be aged 15 years on 31 January in the year of nomination and have held a position of responsibility in their units/groups.

Number of awards

8. It is expected that there will be a couple of awards for each organisation in a borough, but this may be exceeded where there are several units/groups from the same organisation. It is accepted that some boroughs will not always have a candidate of sufficient standard, but this should be the exception.

Recommendation and selection

9. Recommendation and selection is left to the judgement of unit/group leaders and supervisors. They should complete the first page of the attached form electronically **highlighting the skill set and why a young person/cadet merits this award and why they are special (in pen picture form).** The form should be passed up their command structure before being submitted to the regional organisation for final comment. The Representative DL may wish to be brought into the selection procedure at this stage. Finally, the forms should be submitted electronically to GL RFCA to gl-offcadets@rfca.mod.uk by <u>31 January 2025.</u>

10. GL RFCA will then send the recommendations to the appropriate Representative DL for final approval before providing the framed certificates.
